

Dear Parents/Carers,

We have had a lovely week learning about the importance of being kind for Anti-bullying Week. We have been practising our number formation using rhymes to help us. I have sent home a rhyme sheet in your child's reading folder if you would like to practise at home. We learned about the Nativity story, sequenced the events and we started practising the speaking parts for our concert. The children are already amazing!
