Homework

The homework this week will be Maths, we have revisited addition using partitioning. Please keep practicing this method by answering the questions in your homework book. There are 3 columns - what challenge will you choose?

1 Partition both 2-digit numbers into tens and ones. $24 + 35 =$
 $20 + 4 + 30 + 5$

2 Add the tens. $20 + 30 = 50$

3 Add the ones. $4 + 5 = 9$

4 Add the two answers to make the total. $50 + 9 = 59$
