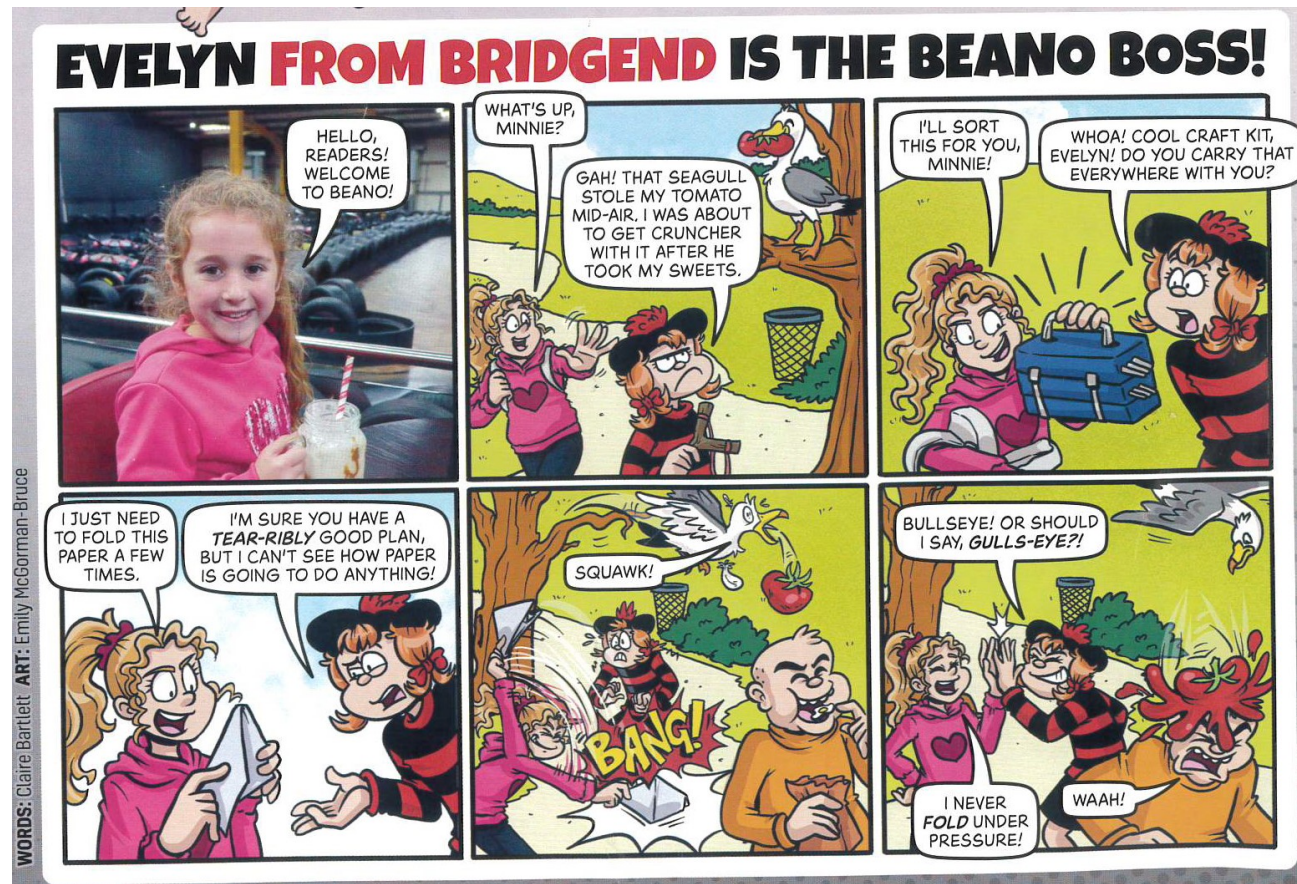


St Brides Pupil turns Beano editor

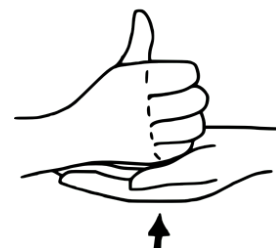
