Maths

This week in Maths, we have been learning about area and how to calculate it for different types of shapes. The children have practised finding the area of:

- Rectangles and squares using the formula *length* x *width*
- Triangles, understanding that the area is *half of a rectangle*
- Compound shapes, where a shape is split into smaller rectangles or triangles before adding the areas together

We have focused on using the correct units (cm² or m²), drawing shapes carefully, and explaining our thinking, showing our workings. Homework is on paper this week and should be done in homework books.

Please help your child to learn the spelling words, there will be a test every Monday.

Class Novel

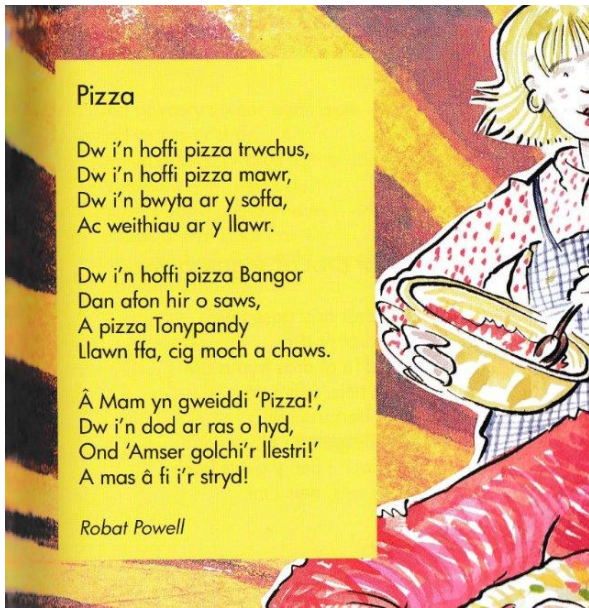
