Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you are well and have had a fantastic Easter break.

This week, our homework will focus on key learning across spelling, maths and our current topic, *Extreme Earth*.

In spelling, the children will be learning words that include the prefix '**inter-**', which means 'between' or 'among'. Encouraging children to spot these words in their reading at home will help to reinforce their understanding. We have a free trial to SumDog spelling so there is a spelling activity for homework to help with this week's words.

In maths, we are focusing on **decimal numbers**, particularly **tenths and hundredths**. The children will be practising recognising, writing and comparing decimals, as well as understanding their place value. You may wish to support this learning by spotting decimals in real-life contexts, such as money. Homework is on SumDog.

Our topic, '**Extreme Earth**', will explore natural disasters and the powerful processes of our planet.
