Fraudulent ParentPay App

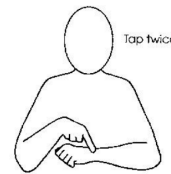

This fake app has been designed to closely imitate the official ParentPay branding, making it appear genuine at first glance. ParentPay's team have acted swiftly in response. They have formally reported the app to Apple and are working closely with them to ensure it is removed as quickly as possible. In the meantime, they are continuing to monitor the situation to prevent any further misuse of the ParentPay name. Please exercise caution and ensure you only download the official ParentPay app. If you are planning to install or update the app, please double-check that it is the legitimate version published by ParentPay Ltd.
