As part of our learning about rockpools and plastic pollution, I would like the children to complete a homework challenge and become Plastic Detectives!

Over the course of the weekend, children should:

- Count how many plastic items their family throws away
- Sort the items into groups (for example: bottles, wrappers, bags or containers)
- Create a simple tally chart or bar graph to show their findings

They should then answer the following questions:

- Which item was thrown away the most?
- What could your family reuse or recycle?
- How could you reduce plastic waste at home?

The results for this can be shown on paper or digitally.
