Thank You FOSB for our Leavers Hoodies

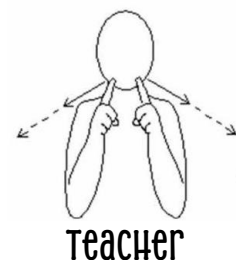

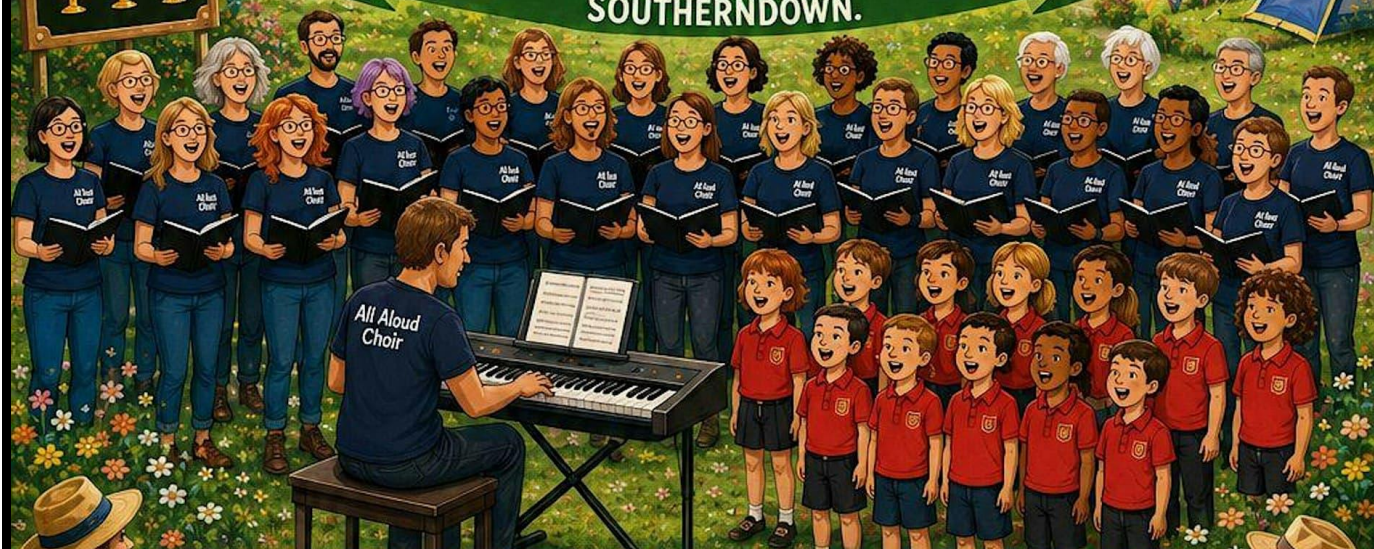
