There are lots of other things we are trying to achieve, so any ideas are appreciated!

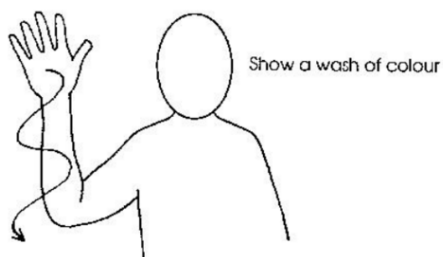

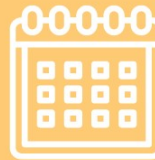
