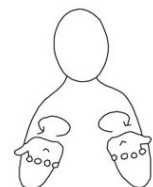

No requirement to attend all dates, each child counts and potentially gains points for the school.

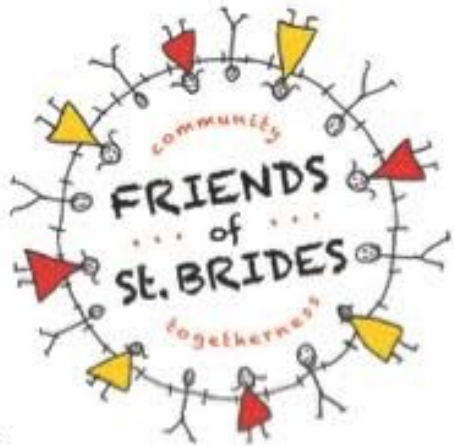
