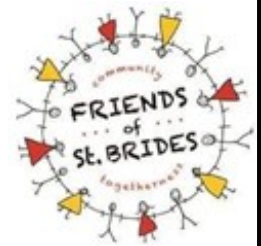
Your donations are raising funds for an outdoor shelter for the foundation yard

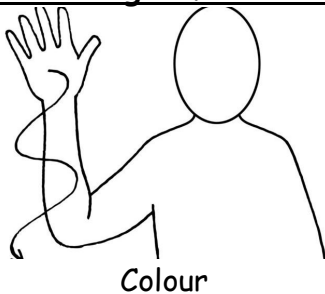
